Founded in 2006, the Veterans of Modern Warfare is the nation's newest national veterans' service organization, focused on mutual assistance to veterans with military service from 1990 – the time of the Persian Gulf War that ushered in a new era of modern warfare – through the present, including the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan.

Mission:

Veterans of Modern Warfare, Inc., (VMW) is a veterans' service organization dedicated to serving our nation's most recent war veterans.
